- AlumawoodTM patio covers that were purchased after February 2004 will have "AMERIMAX ALUMAWOOD" stamped in black ink inside the 2' x 6' Rafters and 3' x 8' Headers (also known as Header Beams). Once product is received, take off the end caps of the 2' x 6' Rafters or 3' x 8' Headers and look inside for the "AMERIMAX ALUMAWOOD" ink stamp (see picture below).
